CITY TO OFFER SPECIAL SANITATION PICK UP PROGRAM USING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS

Good news. You are a resident of the geographic area eligible to receive **one** free special sanitation pick up between now and 12/31/09. This area is east of Kirkwood Road, South of Clinton, west of Leffingwell, and north of I-44.

A fee of \$20 is normally charged for **each** major appliance, large furniture item, tire, or truck hopper load (3' X 3' X 6' – not compacted) of miscellaneous items. Special pick ups must be scheduled in advance by calling 822-5828 before Noon on Wednesdays. Special items will be picked up on your regular Thursday sanitation collection day. The Sanitation department has a list of the addresses of residents with Kirkwood residential sanitation accounts. When you call in to schedule your free special pick up please mention this notice. The Sanitation department will keep track of the pick ups for homes in this area and will bill St. Louis County to be reimbursed through CDBG funds.

If you need to dispose of more than one major appliance or large item, you will be expected to pay for the additional item.

Special pick up service cannot include concrete, bricks, dirt, rocks, limbs, yard waste, or brush. The Sanitation department also cannot pick up hazardous waste such as paint or motor oil. Railroad ties must be cut into three foot lengths.
